Drop Off Time: Anytime between 9AM – 3PM

Format: Contact Less - Collection

1. Secure a large brown paper bag (or any bag)
2. Collect non-perishable items from your home (Only)
3. Fill the bag with items
4. Place items in your trunk of vehicle
5. Drive item over to your drop off location
6. Stay in vehicle
7. Open trunk remotely from vehicle
8. Volunteer will gather bag from trunk
9. Drive away

Recognition: Inform your cubmaster or scoutmaster that you participated in the Scouting For Food event. Aloha Council will collect names and issue patches at a later date.
