# NATIONAL YOUTH LEADERSHIP TRAINING

**Purpose:** The training of youth leaders in the Troop, Team, and Crew is critical to helping individuals and units succeed. The Boy Scouts of America has developed a six-day youth training experience, **National Youth Leadership Training** that has proven valuable in the training of youth leaders. The course stresses the skills of leadership that will make youth leaders more effective in their unit leadership positions. Considered essential by many for Troop SPL, Team Captain, and Crew President, the course is open to youth in any leadership position.

Perhaps most important, the youth will be exposed to personal, teamwork, and leadership skills that will allow them to develop into successful members and leaders of any organization. The course provides youth with the tools they need to develop their own leadership potential. The skills learned will immensely improve the youth-led Troop, Team, or Crew, facilitate the Charter Organization and adult leaders' efforts in leadership development, and directly benefit the unit's program.

**Qualifications:** To attend the Course, Scouts must be at least First Class Scouts, 13 years of age by June 1, 2018, have completed Troop or Varsity Leadership training (TLT/VLT) for their current leadership position or for a leadership position they are likely to assume in the near future, and have their Scoutmaster's or Coach's signature/ written recommendation that the Scout is mature enough to participate in the course. Venturers must be no older than 17 years of age as of June 1, 2018, have completed Venturing Leader Skills Course (VLSC) or Venture Leader Training (VLT). They will also need to have their Advisor's signature and recommendation to participate.

# NYLT FACTS

**Location and dates:** The course will be held from July 16 – 23, 2018 at Camp Honokaia, on Hawaii. The course will model servant leadership principals with adult Course Directors and youth staff leading and teaching.

**What is the course?** National Youth Leadership Training is a six-day outdoor experience for youth.

**How does NYLT work?** Participants are placed in a group setting and split into teams. As Teams, participants engage in a month of unit activities compressed into a fun-filled week of training and experiences. The course strives to teach and provide opportunities to practice what a leader must know and do to be successful in a variety of situations.

### The objectives of NYLT are:

1. Give participants a basic knowledge of the skills of leadership and help relate these skills to their unit responsibilities and personal goals.
2. Give participants the opportunity to share ideas and experiences and develop friendships with Scouts or Venturers from other units.
3. Accomplish these goals by having fun in the outdoors.
4. Give participants the confidence and the knowledge to run their unit's program.
5. Enhance the relationship between the youth participant and their adult leaders.
6. Create an atmosphere where youth will experience Scouting at its best.

**Is any special equipment needed?** An equipment list will be sent to each participant after their reservation is received. An official *Boy Scout Field Uniform or Venturing Uniform* is required. Each participant should make sure that badges and insignia are properly placed and the uniform is worn correctly. Participants will be provided two NYLT t-shirts and a hat (additional shirts may be available for purchase). **The Boy Scout or Venturer Handbook is required.**

**What medical forms are needed?** Each participant must bring a BSA Health and Medical Record with Parts A, B, and C valid through July 16, 2018.

**What Does NYLT cost?** The fee for the course is **\$190.00**. This pays for one hat, two t-shirts, 17 meals, equipment, facilities, and training materials. A deposit of \$50.00 per Scout must accompany each registration. The balance must be paid by May 27, 2018. Late registration, up to June 16, 2018 will cost \$225.00. The fee does not cover BSA uniform, scout handbook, personal gear, or transportation.

**BE ADVISED, ONLY A LIMITED NUMBER CAN ATTEND:** *The course has room for a limited number of participants. If you are considering sending Scouts to NYLT, you should sign them up early to reserve a space. Attempts will be made to have units represented from all over Aloha Council.*

**How does NYLT help the troop, team, or crew?**

The course is designed to strengthen the relationship between youth and adult leaders, improve the unit's program, and help to develop the youth as leaders. Scoutmasters, Coaches, and Advisors should encourage your unit's youth leaders to attend. Adult leaders are invited to an orientation at the Aloha Council Office in April and are encouraged to contact the Course Director with any questions they may have after the orientation.

**Join Us!**

Adult leaders and families are invited to attend the closing ceremony July 21<sup>st</sup> at 7:00 p.m. You are asked **not** to pick your scout up prior to the Closing Ceremony. Participants are expected to assist in the clean-up and close out of the Camp to graduate from the course. This will be ongoing throughout the day on July 21.

## **NYLT Course Fee:**

**\$190.00 per Scout or Venturer participant.**

**NO REFUNDS AFTER June 16, 2018, however, registrations are transferable.**

## **NYLT Course Schedule:**

Check-in at Camp Honokaia at 12:00 noon Monday July 16<sup>th</sup>. Course runs through approximately 8:30 pm. Saturday July 21<sup>st</sup>. Information on arrival times and pre-course meeting will be made available closer to course dates.

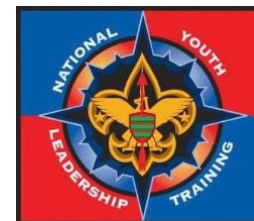
